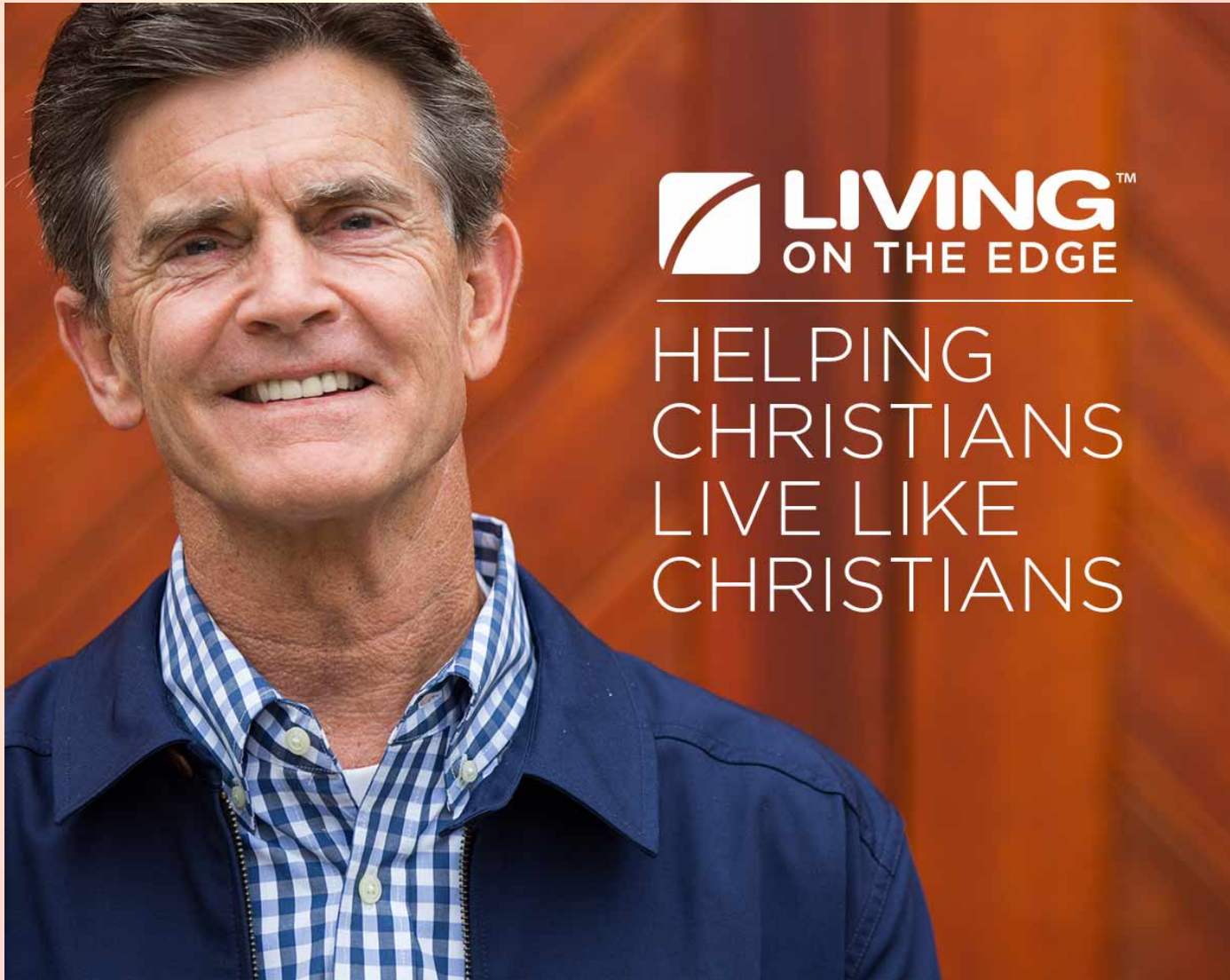

Why I Believe


Romans 10:13-15 (NIV)


